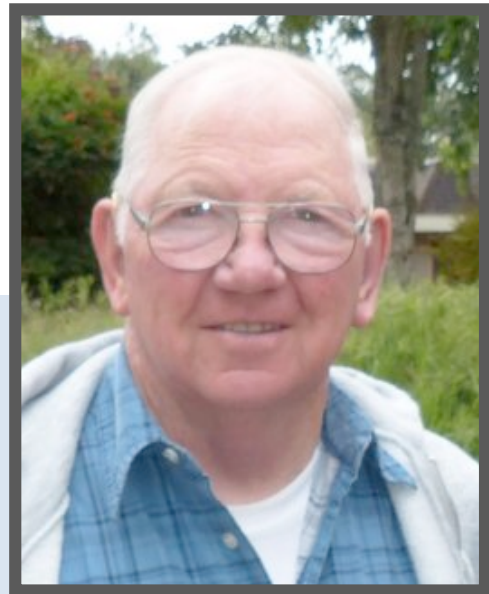


***In Remembrance of
